#### ShyamLal College University of Delhi A Brief Report on Surgical Strike Day 28th and 29<sup>th</sup> Sept, 2018

In September 2016, the Indian Army launched surgical strikes against terrorist camps in Pakistan Occupied Kashmir. The strike on September 28, 2016 was in response to an attack by Pakistan-Based terrorist on an army base in Kashmir's Uri on September 18 in which 19 soldiers were killed. On 29 September 2016, India announced that it conducted surgical strikes against militant launch pads across the Line of Control in Pakistan-administered Kashmir. Since then, the government has been observing September 29 as "Surgical Strike Day".
