

Professional Ethics Programme (2020-21)

Shyam Lal College organized a programme for the faculty members of SLC in staff council meeting held on 30th December 2021 on Zoom platform. Large number of faculty members participated in this programme.

The objective of the programme was basically to ensure that faculty members are apprised of the right code of conduct. This was conducted to draw the attention towards the problems and challenges that are there in front of us at the levels of individual, family, society and nature. It is mainly to increase knowledge and improve ethical thinking.

At the outset of this Programme, Professor Rabi Narayan Kar, Principal, welcomed all the faculty members who had joined the online meeting and provided a brief description of the development and issues of the ongoing semester. There was large number of participants who attended the orientation programme.

Professor Rabi Narayan Kar also highlighted following steps taken by the college towards the improvement in quality of education.

1. The College has made available online reading material to all the students through N-list portal
2. College has also provided link on the college website for the reading material made available by the Delhi University library system and SOL.
3. SLC has successfully implemented mentoring programme through IQAC of the college, for all the students
4. The college has also organized series of Webinars and online discussions on various topics of contemporary relevance.
5. Solar power plant installed in college in collaboration with IPGCL to generate power for our consumption and whenever there is any surplus it goes back to Delhi homes.
6. SLC organised flagship events in its campus to encourage the spirit of Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat & Swachha Bharat Abhiyan in collaboration with Eco Club and Garden committee and the Special attraction was opportunity for Nurseries, handmade art and craft.
7. SLC's Innovation Council works towards inculcating the spirit of innovation among students, and develop a start-up ecosystem.
8. The college provides an enabling environment to differently-abled students through technological and other supports to enable them to perform to the best of their abilities.

9. SLC offers Add-On Certificate and Diploma courses in Foreign languages under the aegis of Department of Germanic & Romance Studies, Department of East Asian Studies.
10. College organizes tree plantation activities to improve the air quality in and around the College, as well as for creating awareness about protection of environment.
11. The College has installed three LED screens to communicate with students and faculty to reduce the use of paper in printing official notices etc.
12. The College gives value-based education to the students (as is the vision of the College) and also takes care of the professionalism of the Industry/market and prepares the students for the competitive world outside.
13. The College aims at promotion and improvement of sports and games in trans-Yamuna region of Delhi by providing opportunities and best coaching facilities to the young and talented players of the society.
14. College has undertaken major infrastructural upgradation with ongoing construction of 2nd Floor in the Old building with several new classrooms, multipurpose Hall, Computer Labs.
15. The College has also constructed an STP plant.
16. Green grass carpeting work was done in College grounds.
17. The committee room has been developed in the Porta Block.
18. Repair renovation has been done in the College Office for smooth conduct of administrative tasks.
19. SLC has initiated various projects under which we are committed, through a structured institutional mechanism, to help rebuild the lives of those students who have been worst affected by the Covid19 and have lost their parent/s and are looking at a grim and uncertain future.
