Street play & lecture on leprosy were organized in collaboration with TLM Community Hospital on 18th Feb'19. Resource Persons said that Leprosy is caused by infection with the bacterium Mycobacterium leprae. It mainly affects the skin, eyes, nose and peripheral nerves. Symptoms include light-coloured or red skin patches with reduced sensation, numbness and weakness in hands and feet. Leprosy can be cured with 6-12 months of multi-drug therapy. Early treatment avoids disability. The main aim was to sensitize the masses about the causes, consequences of leprosy and the discrimination faced by leprosy patients in society. 35 students participate in this event.
