INTRODUCTION

Gandhi Jayanti is celebrated on 2 October annually to mark the birth anniversary of Mohandas Karamchand Gandhi, popularly called Mahatma Gandhi and regarded as the Father of the Nation.

This year marks the 152nd birth anniversary of Gandhi, who was born in Porbandar, Gujarat on 2 October 1869. Father of the Nation, as he was called, led India's freedom movement along with many other national leaders against the British rule in India. His contribution to the Indian freedom struggle is unparalleled, with Gandhi being the architect of several mass movements such as the Non-Cooperation Movement and the Civil Disobedience Movement.

Globally, Gandhi Jayanti is marked as the International Day of Non-Violence, after the United Nations General Assembly (UNGA) adopted a resolution on 15 June 2007. Gandhi's contribution to the propagation of non-violence or ahimsa is recognised by the global body on the occasion.



PROGRAMME:- Celebration of Gandhi Jayanti

On the occasion of Gandhi Jayanti, the NSS unit of Shyam Lal College in collaboration with Sewa: EK Anokha Parivar, a social service organization organised a Blood Donation Camp in the college campus. Around 700 units of blood were collected in this blood donation event. Blood Donation Camp starts at 8 a.m. More than 45 volunteers of NSS participated in this mega event. Every donor was duly taken care of by the volunteers of the NSS group. All the donors were accompanied by the NSS volunteers to the refreshment, breakfast and



awarded a blood donation certificate for donating blood and saving lives. The functioning of the camp went great by the sincere and disciplined efforts of the volunteers of each group present there.

On the same day, the members of the NSS group took a noble initiative of cleaning the River Yamuna at Ghat No. 21. More than 12 volunteers of NSS participated in this event. The cleanliness drive at Ghat No. 21 starts at 9:30 a.m. All the volunteers of NSS were equipped with safety gear, masks, gloves etc. Solid waste from River Yamuna was collected
