Thousands of people visit Ghats of Yamuna River for the Yamuna Aarti on regular basis.

About The Yamuna Festival 3.0

As a maiden attempt to pay homage to the life line of our city, the Yamuna River, Shyam Lal College, University of Delhi conducted the Yamuna Festival on 18th and 19th of April, 2023 at College Campus as well as Yamuna Ghat. Under the able leadership of our respected Principal Sir, Prof. Rabi Narayan Kar, the festival was organized by the NSS. NSS conducted a Plantation drive, rangoli making, and Cleanliness drive, along with a Pledge to conserve the river was held at the Ghat of Yamuna followed by an Eco-friendly Aarti by lighting more than 500 lamps.

- 5. Yamuna Aarti by NSS at Ghat No. 21, Yamuna Bazar.

More than 30 Volunteers of NSS actively participated in this event.

Cleanliness Drive

At 4:00 PM all students conducted a Cleanliness Drive at Ghat No. 21. The Entire Ghat washed with water and cleaned with the help of a Broom. Solid waste are collected and put in the Garbage. All Students were protected with Masks and Rubber Hand Gloves.



Plantation Drive

Around 4:40 PM, Students start with Plantation Drive at Ghat No. 21. Around 10-15 Plants & Flowerpots were Planted at Ghat No. 21 by the Volunteers of the NSS





Rangoli Making

Around 4:50 PM, some students organised also a Eco-friendly Rangoli Making at the Yamuna Ghat No. 21. Students made the Beautiful Rangoli by using the Leaves and Flowers. After that Boating was also done in the Yamuna River by the Volunteers of NSS.





Lamp Lighting & Yamuna Aarti

At 6:00 PM, Volunteers start lighting the Lamps at Ghat No. 21. More than 500 Lamps were arranged at Ghat for the Yamuna Aarti. All Lamps were made up of biodegradable material keeping Yamuna River safe from pollution and organic waste. Around 7:00 pm, all Volunteers participated in the Yamuna Aarti. And one by one Volunteers offered the Milk in the Yamuna River during Aarti. At the end of the Yamuna Aarti, Prasad was distributed by Pandit Ji.


