
Ambedkar Study Circle (ASC), SLC (2019-20)

Essay Writing Competition, 31 October, 2019

To commemorate the Constitution Day (26 November) as well as help students appreciate and sensitize them about Dr. B.R. Ambedkar's understanding of Indian society, Ambedkar Study Centre (ASC), organized an essay writing competition on Thursday, 31st October, 2019 in Room No 203 in the College. The students were asked to read Dr. Ambedkar's autobiography "Waiting for A Visa" and based on his experiences write an essay on any one of the two topics: "Relevance of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar's Experiences of Social Discrimination and Injustice in the Present" Or "Reflections of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar's Autobiographical Note in Various Provisions of Indian Constitution". The essay writing competition received wide enthusiasm among students. Thirty Eight candidates registered out of which twenty three students participated in the competition. Before the start of the competition the Convenor, ASC Dr. Rohan Mandal and Principal and Head of the Institution, Prof. Rabi Narayan welcomed and blessed the students for participating in the program. The members of ASC, Dr. Rajeshwari, Dr. Ruchika Ramakrishnan, Mr. Pankaj Kumar Chaudhary, Mr. Anuj Kushwaha, Dr. Srinivas Misra, Ms. Sumanjeet Kaur and Ms. Suman Rani helped in successful conduct of the program. The jury comprising of Dr. Raj Kumar Prasad, Mr. Anuj Kushwaha and Dr. Awanish Mishra evaluated the essays and then adjudged the best three among them as winner and runners-up. The Ist Prize Winner was Nisha (Roll No-7218) from B.A.(Hons)- IIIrd year from political science, IInd Prize Winner was Mukesh Kumar (Roll No-4089) from B.A.(Prog)-IInd yr. and IIIrd Winner was Satyam Kumar (Roll No-6609) B.A(Hons)-IIIrd year from Economics. The Winner and the next two runners-up were awarded cash prizes of Rs. 1,200/-, Rs.1,000/- and Rs. 800/respectively along with medals and certificates. Consolation prize was given to all the participating students. The winners were declared on 11th November, 2019 on the occasion of seminar to commemorate the Constitution Day. 60 students participated in this event.
