A REPORT ON EDUCATIONAL TRIP BY AMBEDKAR STUDY CIRCLE

An Educational Trip was conducted by Ambedkar Study Circle on April 21st, 2023. Around fifty students including faculty members visited Dr. Ambedkar International Center, the Prime Minister Museum, and the Ambedkar Memorial in New Delhi. The aim of this visit was to increase awareness of the lives and legacies of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar, the architect of the Indian Constitution, and all Prime Ministers of India. This report summarises the visit and highlights some of the key insights gained by the students.

Arrival at the Centers and Museum:

Finally, the group visited the Ambedkar Memorial, which is dedicated to the life and work of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar. The museum has an extensive collection of exhibits related to Dr. Ambedkar's life, including personal belongings, photographs, and letters. After the tour, the students gathered for a group reflection on their visit. They shared their thoughts and impressions of the three venues and their exhibits. Some of the key takeaways included:


