Action Taken

Since 15.78% students disagreed to the Skill Enhancement learning, the College would be offering a variety of *Skill* Enhancement courses under the UGCF being introduced from academic session 2022-23. The issue can be further addressed with mentoring and counselling about the career opportunities and possibilities of higher education progression.

As 16.29% respondents disagreed for the *Academic Activities*. Due to Covid-19 Pandemic, the entire teaching learning shifted to online mode. Thus, there was a little diminished exposure for students in Seminars/Conferences/Workshops, Hands on Training for Academic Enhancement (Software, Simulation, databanks etc.). This issue would automatically be resolved as the physical classes and interactions resumed.
