- **Art from Heart**

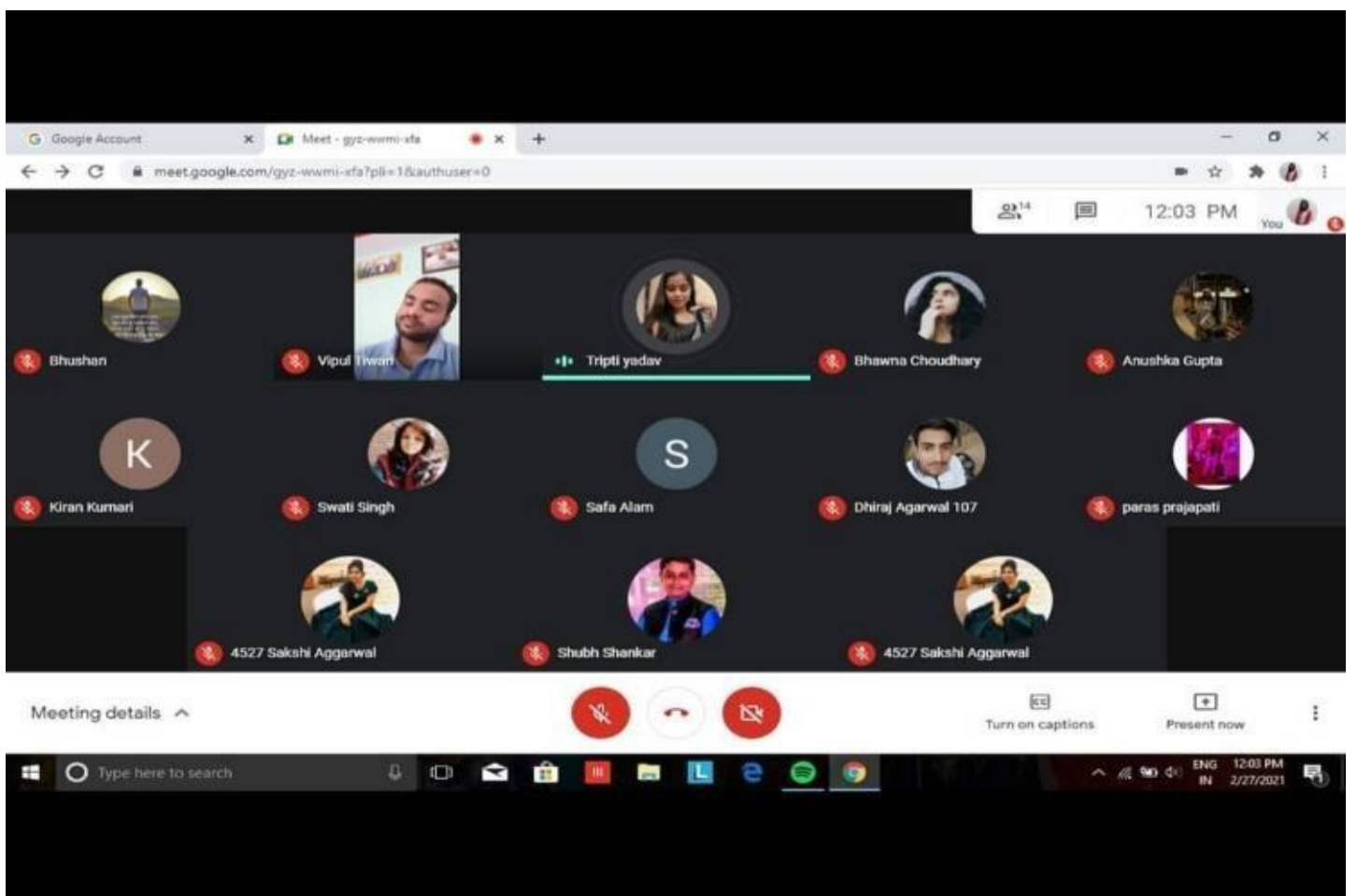
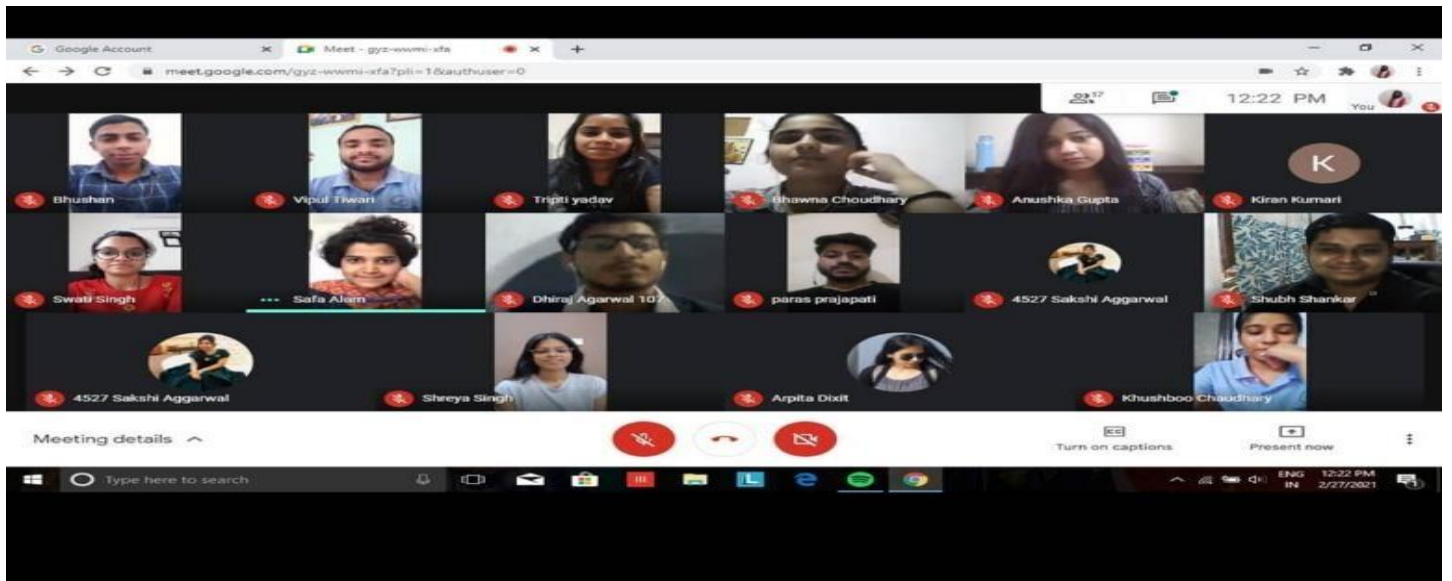
