• Quiz Mania

Number of participants: 75

Brief description:-

The annual fest of UDGAM B.A. Programme Society of Shyam Lal College (University of Delhi), Vasantotsav 2024, held on 18th April, organized a quiz competition named Quiz Mania.

Quiz Mania was divided into two engaging rounds, testing participants' knowledge and understanding of various domains. The first round provided participants with a choice to select a domain from a given list that included History, Geography, Science and Technology, Sports, and Entertainment. The second round involved a PowerPoint presentation containing an array of questions from History, Geography, Current Affairs, Science and Technology, and Sports. The marking scheme for the second round was designed with +4 reward for a correct answer, -1 deduction for an incorrect response or passing the question and the number of participants was 22 and 12 respectively.

Results were declared based on the combined marks of both rounds, and winners were awarded certificates, trophies, and exciting prizes for their accomplishments.

• Talking Titans

Number of participants: 27

Brief description:-

On 17th and 18th April 2024, the extempore event named Talking Titans was led under the guidance of coreadvisor, Lakshya Bhatia.

The first round was conducted online in which participants were given the topic on the spot and carried it out without preparation, they were given a certain time limit for preparing and speaking which improves one's ability to think and speak on the spot. Participants were free to choose a language between Hindi and English but will have to maintain it till the end. Bilingualism was not allowed. Each participant had one minute to think about the topic and two minutes to deliver it. The event consisted of two rounds in which eight participants were selected for the final round. The final round was conducted in Room No. 202 in SLC campus.

Number of participants: 64

Brief description:

The event was scheduled on the college campus in room no. 208. The event started at 1:00 P.M.. The event commenced at 1:40 P.M. with a short briefing by our executive member Miss Aditi. The time limit for the teams to find out all the clues was 45 minutes and assembled in room no 208. Otaku Odyssey

Number of participants: 24

Brief Description:

On 18th April, 2024 an event named 'Otaku Odyssey: Anime trivia challenge' was conducted by UDGAM: B.A. Programme society in room no 103 in our college. It was led under the guidance of core advisor, Sneha Pal. It was conducted in 2 rounds and the questions were given through Google Forms via individual's device.Round 1 was a preliminary round. There were 20 multiple-choice questions given and were based on different genres of anime series. There was no negative marking, and the time limit was given 10 minutes. In the first round, 24 participants appeared, out of which 10 members qualified for the second round. The second round consisted of 15 questions divided into three parts: the first part was 5 MCQ-based and the time given was 10 minutes. The second part was based on openings or theme songs 5 five different anime series, qualifiers had to select the right option.
