Eligibility Criteria:

1. Certificate Course in German Language:

- a) Minimum eligibility is 10+2 with 45% aggregate.
- b) Employees of the University of Delhi and other recognized Universities are also eligible.
- c) Duration - 150 hours (2 hrs. class to be held thrice a week for each language)

2. All courses in German are affiliated to the Department of Germanic and Romance Studies, University of Delhi.

3. **Minimum number of students** (German course): 20

Maximum number of students in each batch of German course: 50

Registration begins in last week of May every year.

Commencement of course: First week of August.
