Report- Professional ethics programme (2019-20)

ShyamLal College organized a programme for the faculty members of SLC in staff council meeting held on 01 June, 2019 at college Staff Room. Large number of faculty members participated in the programme. The aim of this programme was mainly to ensure that faculty members are acquainted of the right code of conduct. It serves not only as a set of internal guidelines for the employees to follow, but also as an external statement of values and commitments. It was mainly oraganized to draw the attention towards the problems and challenges that are there in front of us at the levels of individual, family, society and nature. It is mainly to increase knowledge and improve ethical thinking.

At the beginning of this Programme, Prof. Rabi Narayan Kar, Principal, introduced the issue of professional ethics and code of conduct to all the faculty members who had attended the meeting and provided a brief description of the development and issues of the ongoing semester.

Professor Rabi Narayan Kar also highlighted following steps taken by the college towards the improvement inquality of education.

- 4. SLC provide a facilitating environment to differently-abled students through technological and other supports to allow them to perform to the best of their abilities.
- 5. The IQAC of the College continuously undertakes many activities like FDPs, SDP, workshop and conferences, symposium and remedial classes for overall development of students.

- Solar power plant installed in college in collaboration with IPGCL to generate power for ourconsumption and whenever there is any surplus it goes back to Delhi homes.
- 7. The college is a tobacco-free zone and has said a loud 'NO' to crackers and plastic bags.
- 8. SLC also used garden waste for making compost in composit pits.

After the brief introduction by Principal, Professor Rabi Narayan Kar the Code of Professional Ethics was discussed by Staff Council Secretary Sri Pankaj Kumar Chaudhary. Thereafter Dr. Ruchika Ramakrishnan highlighted that teacher should set a positive example and inculcate valuable life lessons in students by settinga positive example.
