“Skit On No Smoking”

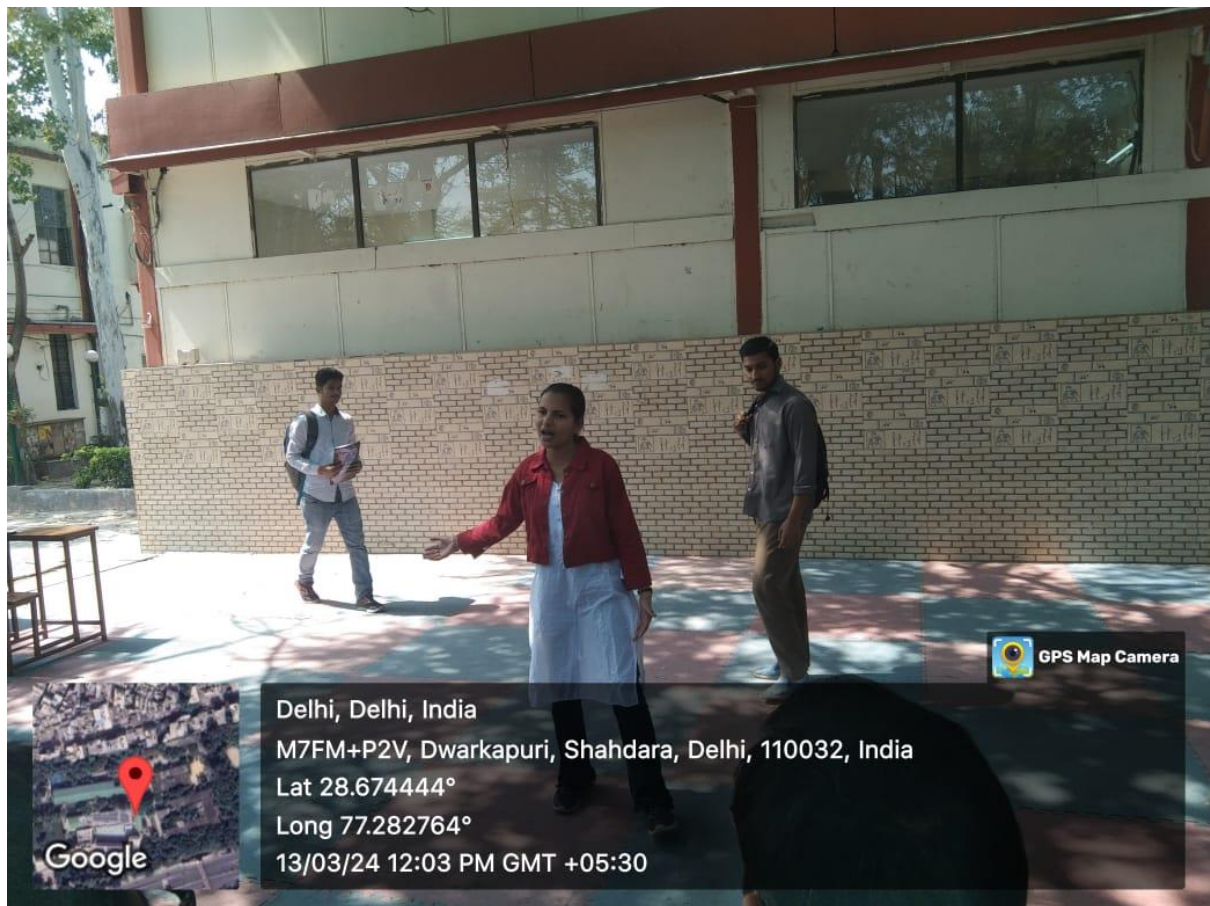
13th March, 2024
