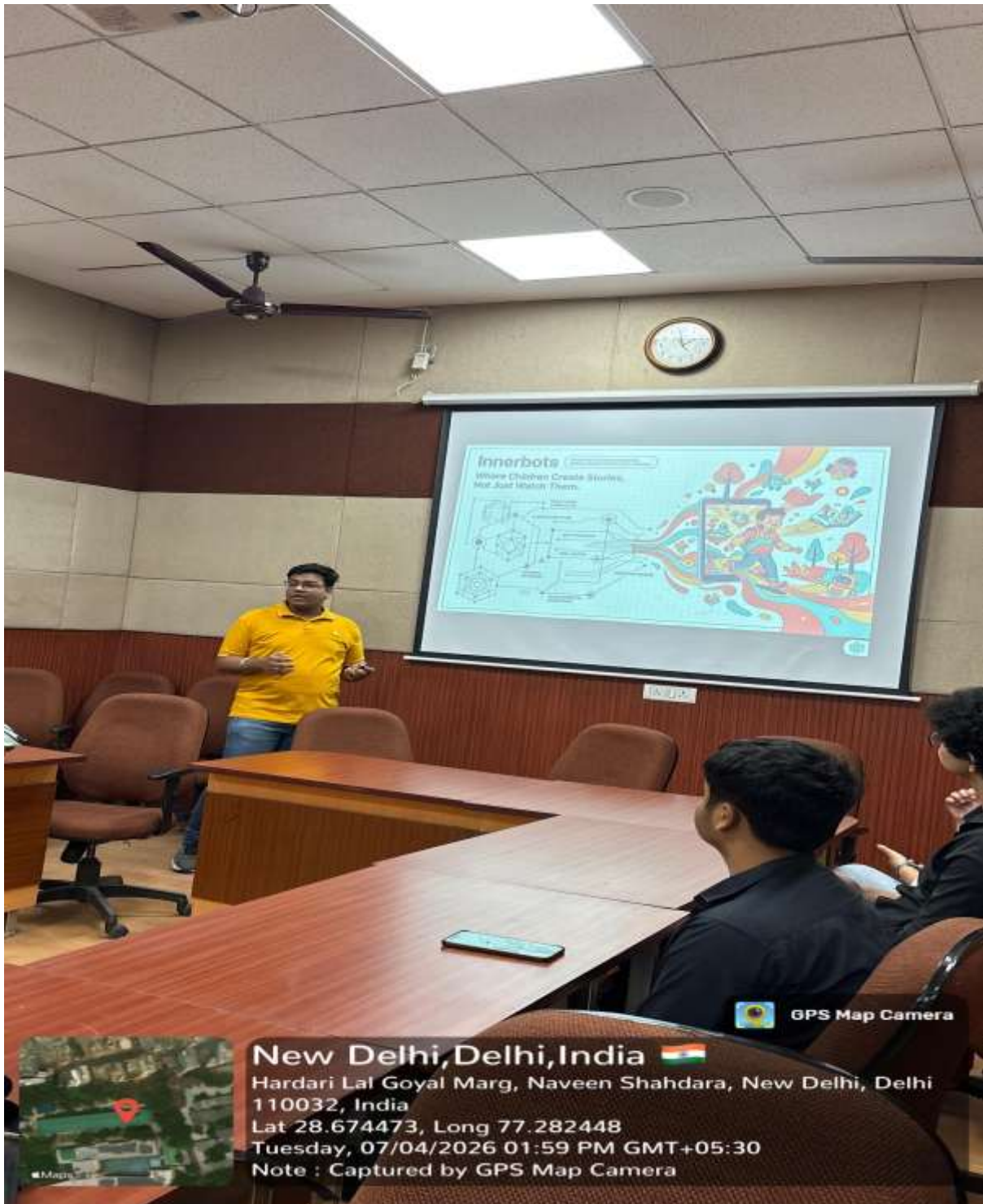


PREPARATIONS

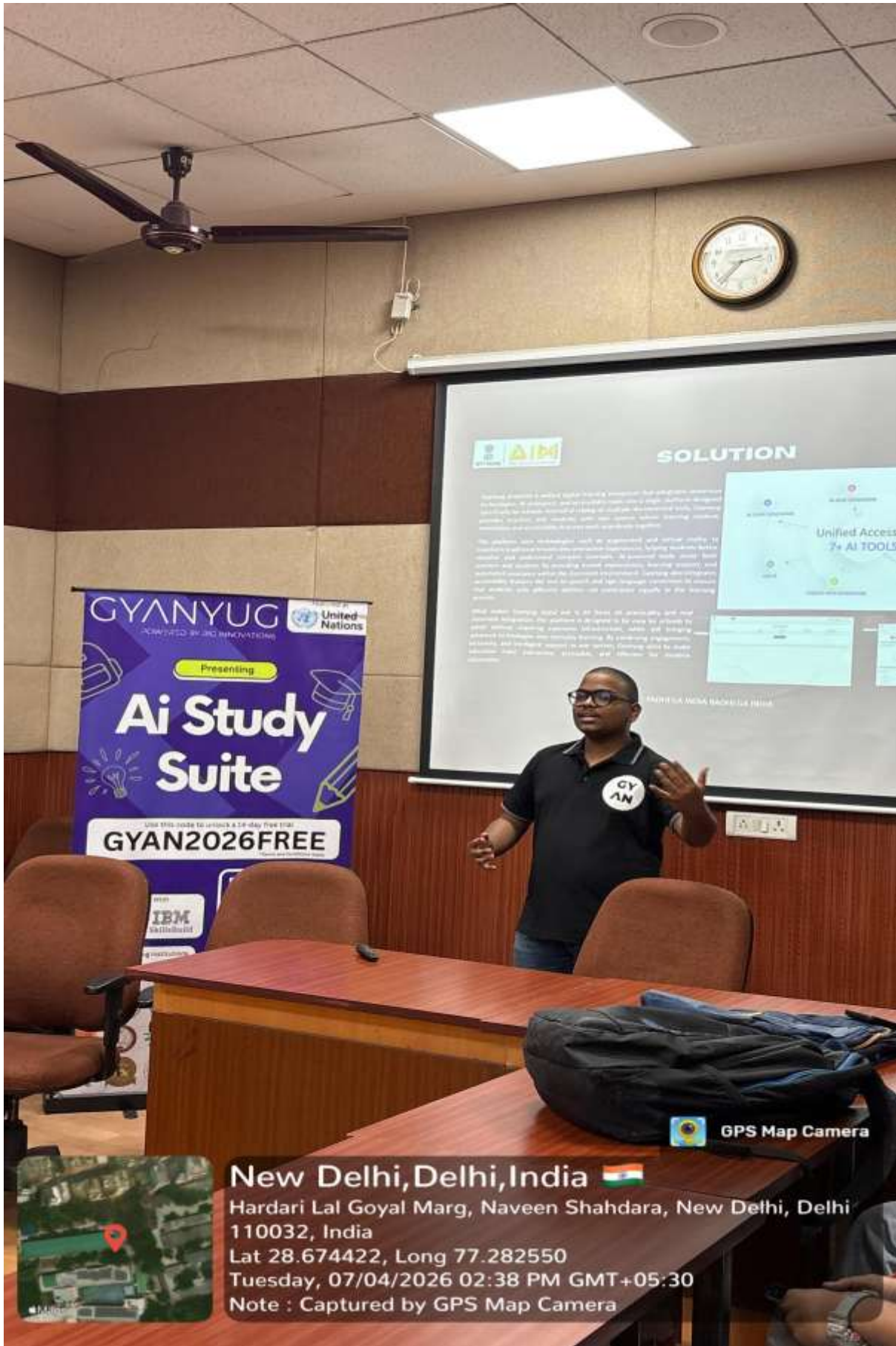

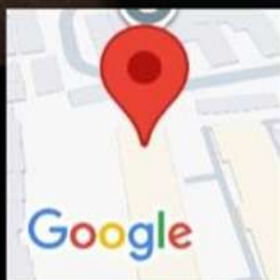
