Introduction:

Yuvaspandana'24, an annual extravaganza jointly organized by the Entrepreneurship Cell (E-Cell) and Center for Skill Development Society (CSD), marked a celebration of creativity, entrepreneurship, and strategic thinking. Among the array of events, "QUICK PITCH," Challenge organized by the E-Cell, an electrifying event where our budding entrepreneurs pitched their innovative product.



Event Overview: The Quick Pitch event held on March 15 in the Seminar Hall at 10AM witnessed enthusiastic participation from 20 students representing SLC and inter colleges such as KMC, Bhim Rao Ambedkar College. Khushi Gaur, Poorvi Singhal were event heads

with assistance from Deepanshi, and volunteers Somya and Bhagritee, under the guidance of Dr. Bharat Garg (Convenor ecell) and Ms. Palak Kakkar (Faculty ecell) the event aimed to test participants' ability to think on their feet and deliver persuasive pitches for various products.

Event Details: Participants were randomly given chits containing different products. They were then given 2 minutes to gather their thoughts and prepare a pitch for the assigned product. Subsequently, each participant had 3 minutes to deliver their pitch, showcasing their creativity, communication skills, and persuasive abilities.

THE JUDGMENT CRITERIA WAS:-

- 1.Clarity How clearly the pitch communicated the product.
- 2.Engagement Engaging and capture the audience.
- 3.Delivery The delivery of pitch includes tone, pace and body language.
- 4.Creativity Highlighted what sets the product from competitors emphasizing the USP of the product.
- 5. Feasibility The practicality of implementing or realizing the items.

Outcome: After all pitches were delivered, judges Palak Ma'am and Bharat Sir deliberated and selected three winners based on the quality of their pitches.
