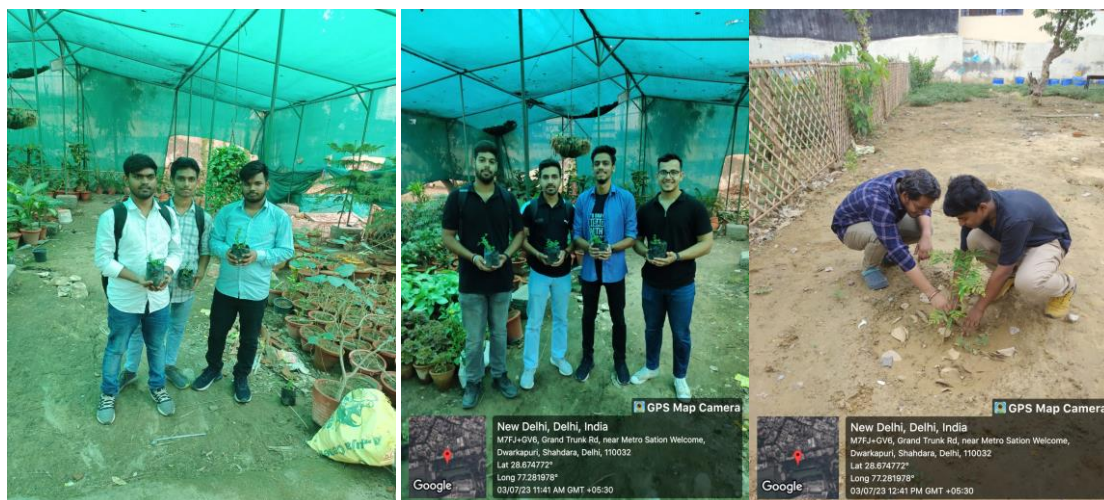

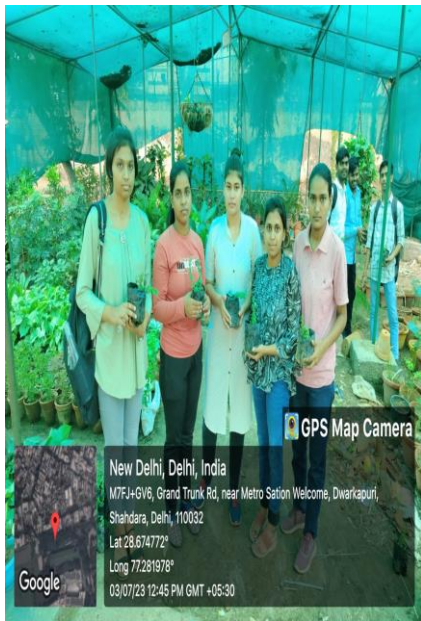

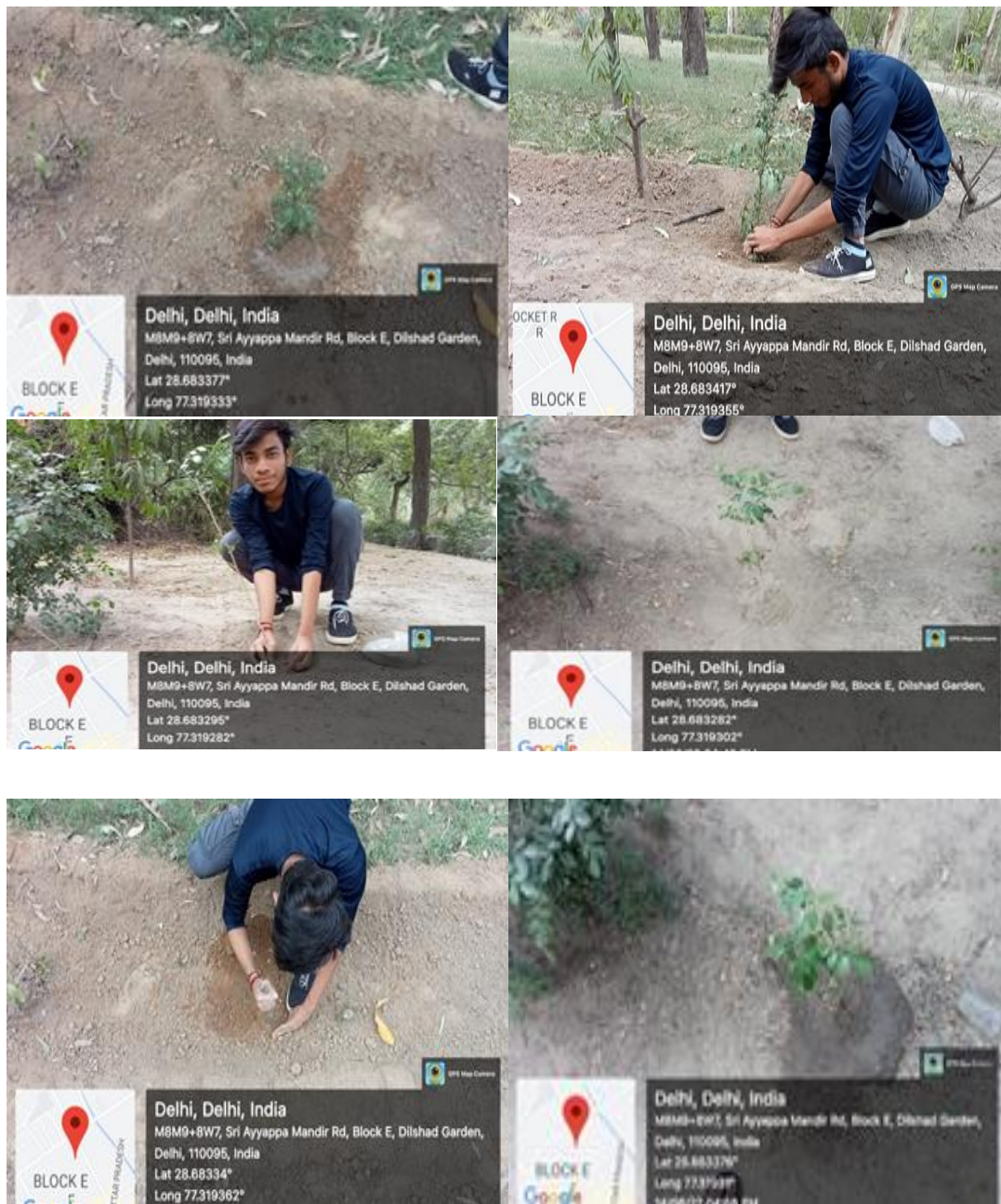
Activity: 1
