On April 7th, 2025, Pitch Perfection'25—our flagship B-Plan competition—kicked off with an exciting and intellectually stimulating online preliminary round. This round marked the first phase of our nationwide search for the most promising and innovative business ideas among aspiring entrepreneurs.

We received enthusiastic participation from approximately 60 teams, representing prestigious institutions across India, with a significant turnout from various colleges affiliated with Delhi University. Each team, comprising 2 to 4 members, came forward with original, impactful business plans aimed at addressing real-world problems through sustainable, scalable, and smart solutions.

Over the span of 4.5 hours, these teams presented their concepts with impressive clarity, depth, and conviction. Their pitches effectively communicated their mission (short-term objectives), vision (long-term aspirations), and implementation feasibility, showcasing not just creativity but also strategic foresight.

The judging panel—comprising experienced professionals and domain experts—meticulously evaluated each team on several critical parameters. These included the feasibility of the idea, potential impact, strength of the business model, and the presentation and communication skills of the team members.

Following a rigorous assessment process, the top 32 teams were shortlisted to proceed to the highly anticipated final round. These teams stood out for their innovative thinking, clarity of execution, and the ability to convincingly articulate how their ideas could bring tangible change.

The preliminary round not only set a high benchmark for the competition but also reflected the vibrant entrepreneurial spirit of young minds across the country.

DAY 2 – FINAL ROUND - PITCH PERFECTION'25



The final round of Pitch Perfection'25 took place on April 8th, 2025, in an offline setting at Shyam Lal College, University of Delhi. The atmosphere was charged with excitement and anticipation as the top 23 shortlisted teams prepared to showcase their entrepreneurial acumen on a grander platform.

The event commenced at 9:45 AM with a spiritually uplifting Saraswati Vandana, invoking the blessings of the goddess of knowledge and wisdom. This was followed by the soulful rendition of the Delhi University Kulgeet, setting a dignified and inspiring tone for the day's proceedings.

JUDGING PANEL

The final round of Pitch Perfection '25 was evaluated by a panel of five esteemed faculty members from Shyam Lal College, each bringing with them a wealth of knowledge, academic insight, and critical perspective. Their expertise played a crucial role in ensuring a fair and comprehensive assessment of each team's business proposal.



The panel consisted of the following distinguished judges:

- Dr. Nidhi Jain – A respected academic with a strong background in commerce and entrepreneurial development.
- Dr. Neha Bothra – An expert in business strategy and innovation, known for encouraging critical thinking among students.
- Dr. Diksha – Recognised for her analytical skills and in-depth knowledge of marketing and business ethics.
- Dr. Kanika Solanki – A dynamic faculty member with experience in evaluating student-led business and research projects.

Together, the judging panel carefully evaluated each team based on multiple criteria, including originality of the idea, social and commercial viability, execution strategy, team dynamics, and presentation effectiveness. Their constructive feedback not only helped in identifying the top performers but also guided participants towards refining their ideas for future growth and implementation.

PRESENTATIONS AND ENGAGEMENT

In the final round of Pitch Perfection'25, each team was allotted a total of 15 minutes—with 10 minutes dedicated to presenting their business plan and 5 minutes reserved for an engaging Q&A session with the judging panel. This structure not only tested the participants' clarity of thought and communication but also their ability to think on their feet and defend their ideas with conviction.

The ideas presented by the teams were diverse, socially conscious, and rooted in real-world relevance. From solutions targeting grassroots-level problems in rural India to tech-driven platforms addressing urban inefficiencies, the range of ideas was truly inspiring. Every pitch reflected a shared commitment to innovation, sustainability, and scalability, aligning with both national priorities and global challenges.



Many teams addressed critical concerns such as sanitation, nutrition, education, digital accessibility, environmental conservation, and women's empowerment, showcasing how entrepreneurship goes beyond profit-making to embrace problem-solving and value creation. Overall, the event effectively highlighted entrepreneurship as a powerful catalyst for economic development, with the potential to significantly advance Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), create employment opportunities, and strengthen Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR)—where purpose and profit align seamlessly.

EVENT OUTCOMES AND HIGHLIGHTS

The final round was a resounding success, both in terms of participation and the quality of ideas presented. The event served as a platform for young innovators to voice their solutions to contemporary problems, many of which were deeply rooted in social, environmental, and economic impact.
