Key Highlights

2. Session by Mr. Naman Jain

 - Highlighted the importance of:
 - Technical Preparation: Mastering DSA, system design, and problemsolving.
 - Soft Skills: Communication, adaptability, and teamwork.
 - Resilience: Learning from feedback and staying motivated.

- Advised students to:
 - Focus on niche skills (e.g., cloud computing, AI) to stand out.
 - Leverage platforms like LeetCode and GitHub for practice and visibility.

3. Session by Mr. Kapil Gulati

- Topic: "Breaking into Cybersecurity: Lessons from IBM, HCL, and Accenture"
 - o Discussed his transition from a fresher to a Security Consultant at IBM.
 - Key takeaways:
 - Certifications Matter: Recommended CEH, CISSP, and CompTIA Security+.
 - Networking: How LinkedIn and alumni connections helped him secure referrals.
 - Mock Interviews: Practicing with peers to overcome nervousness.
 - Stressed the value of ethical hacking labs and contributing to open-source projects.

4. Interactive Q&A

Students asked questions about:

- Handling interview anxiety.
- Balancing higher studies with job preparation.
- Negotiating salary packages.
