Each panel comprises a small team of participants who deliberate on a selected theme allotted during registration. Panels are evaluated by a distinguished jury based on content accuracy, originality, clarity of expression, teamwork, and overall impact. The Inter-College Panel Discussion aims to create a stimulating intellectual environment where students can explore contemporary issues, cultivate global perspectives, and strengthen their understanding of complex topics.
