The panelists shared their personal journeys, challenges, and groundbreaking innovations, inspiring students with their stories of resilience and creativity. The session concluded with an interactive Q&A, where students posed thoughtful questions and gained valuable insights into the world of sustainable entrepreneurship.

The final rounds of Bid Magnate and Innowave took place, with participants presenting their strategies and solutions to a panel of judges. The winning teams were awarded with **prizes worth Rs. 1,60,000 including cash prizes** and certificates, recognizing their innovation and strategic prowess.

Day 2 transformed the college campus into a vibrant hub of activity. Enactus stalls of various colleges like SGBT Khalsa, Ramjas, ANDC, etc., showcased flagship projects highlighting their community impact and sustainable practices.
